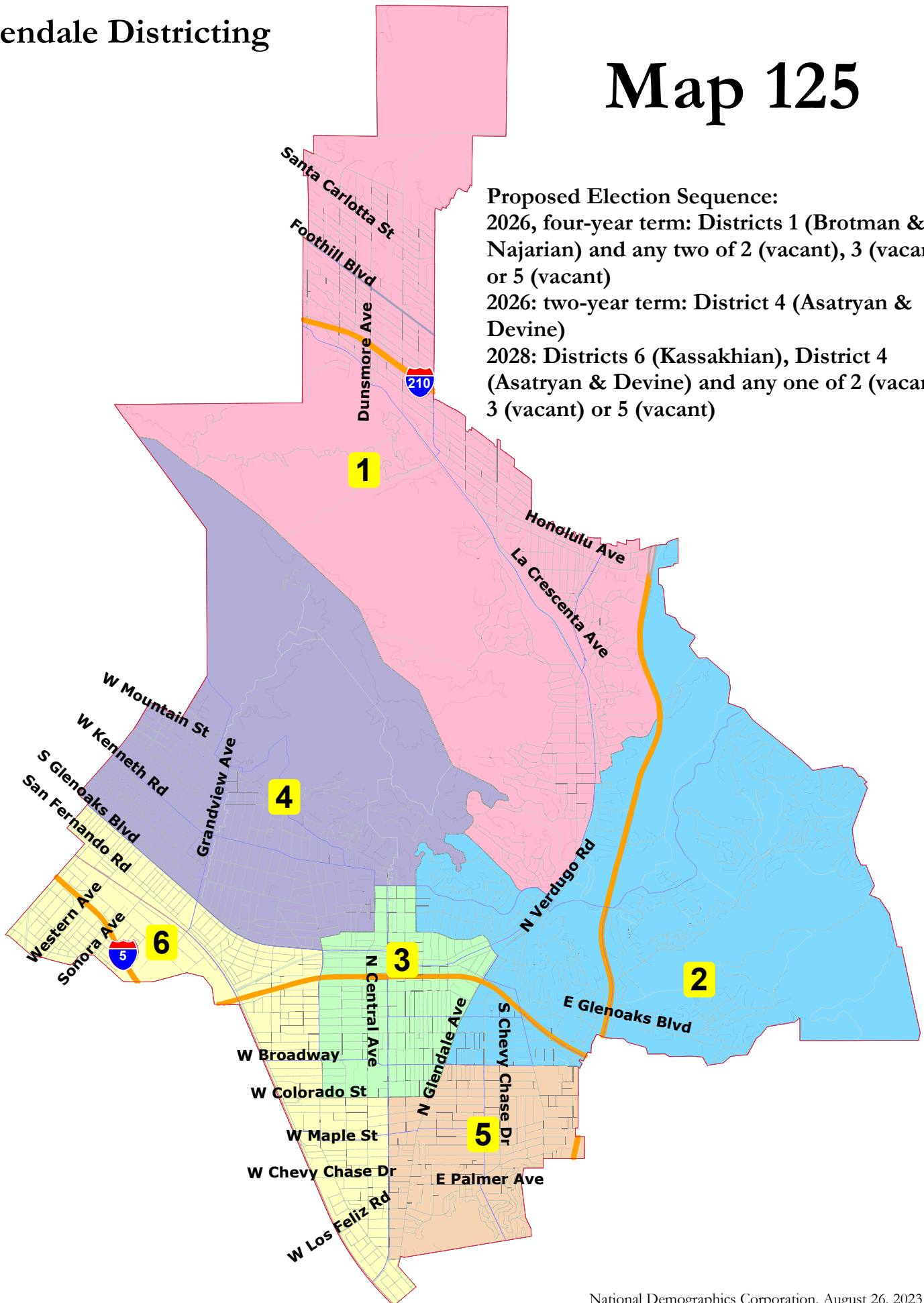
# Map 125
